

# INFORMATION BULLETIN NO.1

## IDBF WORLD NATIONS CHAMPIONSHIPS – 18th to 22nd October 2017

### DATE

The 13th IDBF World Nations Championships will be held from the 18th to 22nd October 2017. Competing teams are advised to arrive in Kunming no later than Tuesday, 17th October 2017. Teams arriving earlier will be catered for.

#### **LOCATION**

The World Nations Championships will be held in Kunming, Yunnan, China. Racing will take place on the Dianchi Lake, which located in Xishan District of Kunming city. It takes about 50 minutes from Kunming Changshui International Airport by car, and about 40 minutes from Kunming High-Speed Rail Station to Dianchi Lake by car. The temperature in October is about 12°C-20°C.

### **REGATTA COURSE**

The regatta course and technical facilities will be to IDBF standards for World Championships. The number of racing lanes will be six over 200m, 500m, 1000m and 2000m, with a width of 13.5m and a depth of 3.5m.

### **BOATS AND EQUIPMENT**

IDBF licensed boats will be provided by the Championship Organizers. Competing teams will be expected to bring their own paddles that conform to the IDBF Paddle Specification 202a. A limited number of IDBF Spec 202a paddles will be provided by the Organizing Committee.

#### **COMPETITION FORMAT**

The Championships will be conducted according to the IDBF Competition Regulations and IDBF Rules of Racing by appointed IDBF International Race Officials assisted by National Standard Officials, under the direction of an IDBF Chief Official, with a Championship Jury nominated by the IDBF Executive Committee.

The Championship will use the IDBF Race plans to determine the racing program.

### **VISAS**

Teams requiring visas to enter China should apply directly to the Organizing Committee no later than (30th June 2017), email requesting a letter of invitation to the 13th IDBF World Nations Championships and enclosing a list of those participants who have been selected for the Team, including any Officials and Supporters who are attending the Championships.



### **NEW IDBF RULES AND REGULATIONS**

The IDBF Competition Regulations and Rules of Racing Edition 7 effective from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2016 will be used.

Please make sure you familiarize yourselves with these rules which can be found on the IDBF website at www.idbf.org as there are changes to the male / female ratio in the mixed crew composition, additionally there were changes to the 2000m rules.

### **DIVISIONS, RACING & COMPETITION CLASSES & ENTRY CONDITIONS**

#### **ENTRIES**

All entries must be made by the IDBF member for the country, where one exists. Teams from countries or territories where there is not an IDBF member may compete, subject to the agreement of the IDBF Executive Committee.

The Championship Divisions, Racing and Competition Classes that will be contested are listed below. Both Standard and Small Boat Championships are on offer with the Small Boat Races primarily aimed at new Countries on the international stage, but also at Countries with only a small number of paddler available for a particular Racing Class or Classes.

Classes may be combined in the early rounds of competition, but the Grand Finals will usually be separate.

A Country can enter Standard or Small Boat Crews or both in all Racing Classes but for a Country to enter both a Standard and Small Boat crew in the same Divisional Racing Class or competition, the racers (paddlers, helms and drummers) in the small boat crew must be completely different racers from those used in the standard boat crew including reserves.

### **MIXED CREWS EXCEPTION**

A Country may enter an Open Standard Boat and also a Women's Small Boat Crews or vice versa, in any Racing Class. These crews can combine and also race in a Standard Boat Mixed Crew but **NOT** in a Small Boat Mixed Crew.

Teams who enter both a Small Boat Open and Small Boat Women's Crews will be required to enter a Standard Boat Mixed Crew and **NOT** a Small Boat Mixed Crew.

**Double roster of paddlers between Divisions is discouraged.** Helms and Drummers may be used across the Divisions (subject to the rules for Junior and Senior) but in the case of 'back to back races' the Officials will **NOT** delay races for Helms / Drummers to transfer between crews.

### **CLASSES AND DISTANCES**

Races will be held for the following Racing Classes in both the Standard Boat and Small Boat categories.

In order for a competition class to qualify for the World Championship Status no less than **SIX** entries from different countries are required. Classes with **THREE** to **FIVE** entries will be given IDBF Championship status and less than **THREE** will be held as Demonstration Races.

### **BOAT TYPE - STANDARD AND SMALL BOATS**

Small Boat Racing is intended for new and developing IDBF Member Countries; that is generally the IDBF Basic and Associate Members. IDBF Members who have taken part in a WDBRC in the past four (4) years but are unable to send Standard Boat Crew may be permitted to compete in the Small Boat Championships by application to the Chair of the IDBF and C&CTC. For example; an IDBF Member with only twelve (12) paddlers of either sex available, who has competed in a previous WDBRC may be allowed to enter a Small Boat Crew in the appropriate class / category.

### **ON-LINE REGISTRATION**

On-line registration will be open at the official IDBF Championship website <a href="https://idbfchamps.org/idbf">https://idbfchamps.org/idbf</a> from 26th May 2017. Passwords for Team managers to this system will now be issued directly by your Governing Federation. Slawek Borucki will be issuing full details to each Governing Federation before this date.

#### **IDBF Registration Fees**

An IDBF Registration Fee of USD 36.00 per accredited person, will be payable directly to the IDBF by 1<sup>st</sup> September with the final named entries, in respect of every participant attending the World Championships.

A reduced fee of USD 22.00 has been agreed for registered Supporters. The fee will entitle people to receive an accreditation card which makes possible to enter the competition areas. The competition site (besides the boarding zone) will be **NOT** open to the public.

### Details of the IDBF bank account will be provided in Bulletin 2.

The IDBF will provide an invoice based on the country / team registration. Details of the bank payment will be shown on the IDBF invoice. Payment is only to be made after the invoice has been received.

### **PERSONAL SAFETY**

All crew members must be water confident and ideally be able to swim at least 50m. It is the Crew Manager's responsibility to ensure that this limitation is complied with, and to ensure that known weak swimmers wear personal flotation aids. Crews compete entirely at their own risk and must be 'Fit to Race', as defines in the IDBF Competition Regulations.

### **ACCOMODATION**

Information on all the types of accommodation available in Kunming will be announced later.

### **MEALS**

It will be possible to book lunch or dinner at the regatta course. More details will be available in Information Bulletin No. 2 (price, booking deadline etc).
